



## College Park Middle School IB MYP Magnet Magnet Enrollment Agreement

***We aim to inspire and empower a diverse community of learners in an academically rigorous and motivating environment. Through intercultural understanding, mutual respect, integrity and civic responsibility, we celebrate and develop an appreciation of our differences.***

In order to maintain an educational environment that will be the foundation for success, introduce global perspectives and a gateway to leadership, the students and parents who choose the College Park Middle School IB Magnet Program will be required to adhere to the following:

- Students must be able to accommodate a full magnet schedule each year of the program.
- Students must maintain a 3.0 or higher in all classes based on report card and cumulative grades with no final grade of F in any class.
- Students and Parents will complete and support academic requirements.
- Students and Parents must demonstrate and support appropriate behavior and follow the OCPS Student Code of Conduct.
- Students are expected not only to attend school daily, but be prompt in arriving to class. Written excuses must accompany any absence.
- Students will participate in required performances, competitions, or auditions.
- Students will complete community service requirements.
- 8<sup>th</sup> grade students will complete the Community Project.
- Students and parents will follow and support the schools MYP policies to include the Academic Honesty Policy.
- Students will study the selected art throughout the course of the three years of the program.
- To obtain the College Park Middle School Middle Years Program Certificate students must:
  - Participate in at least two years of the three year program
  - Complete Community Service Requirements for each year of the program. (Students that enter in year 2 must also complete requirements for year 1)
  - Successfully complete the requirements of all 8 subject groups for each year in the program.
  - Successfully complete the Community Project with a score equal or greater to 3 for each objective.

**In the event that these guidelines are not followed the provisions below apply:**

Students who fail to meet the standards established in this agreement will be placed on probation. The parent will be notified and a parent conference will be scheduled upon request. Probation will be for one marking period. If the violation is corrected during that time period, the probationary period will end. If there is insufficient improvement at the conclusion of the probation period, the student will be exited from the magnet program and will be required to return to the **zoned school**, if applicable.

**Students will be offered support via the following:**

Academics – After School tutoring with College Park Middle School teachers . Before school tutoring for specific high school credit courses; Parent- Teacher-Student conferences.

Behavior – Restorative Justice; Guidance referrals; Small group support sessions; Parent-Teacher-student conferences.
